Dora Wang started her professional music career at the Affiliated Middle School of Tianjin conservatory of music with a major in bamboo flute in 1998. During her studies, she mastered all different performing styles and developed skills in other Chinese musical instruments, such as xiao, xun, bawu, and hulusi. In 2003, she was awarded the Second Place Award in a national professional completion in China and was invited to visit Europe on different occasions to perform on the Chinese bamboo flute as an inter-culture exchange performer. She graduated from the conservatory in 2008 and in the same year she held her first successful recital. After immigrating to Canada, she founded her band, Melody of Bamboo Music, and performed at many major events in Canada. In February of 2015, she performed as a soloist for Chinese New Year, celebrating the music of China and Hungary with Canadian Sinfonietta at the Glenn Gould Studio, and in November of the same year, she performed for The Memory Palace of Matteo Ricci with Toronto Chamber Choir at the Church of the Redeemer
