What do I need to use Electronic Check payment?


To process your chequing information for RCM online, you will need to review a void cheque to look for two types of numbers:

- Account Number
- Routing Number

<u>Note:</u> The length of account number and routing number will vary for each bank. Please only enter what you see on the check. Avoid adding extra zeros (0).

How do I find an Account Number?


Account Number can be found on a cheque.



How do I find the Routing Number?

Routing number consists of Institution ID Number followed by Branch Number found on a cheque.

(Institution ID Number) + (Branch Number)



Routing Number = (Institution ID Number) + (Branch Number)

- First Enter Institution ID Number
- Then Enter Branch Number

Below are some Institution ID Numbers for common Canadian banks that may help you identify your Account Number and Routing Numbers

- XXXXX-001 Bank of Montreal
- XXXXX-002 Bank of Nova Scotia
- XXXXX-003 Royal Bank of Canada
- XXXXX-004 <u>Toronto-Dominion Bank</u> (which is the legal name for the bank, although it operates as <u>TD Canada Trust</u>)
- XXXXX-006 National Bank of Canada
- XXXXX-010 Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce (includes President's Choice Financial)
- XXXXX-016 HSBC Canada
